

# Faculty Council Report

## July 2021

This report will provide an overview of what has been discussed in the TiSEM Faculty Council, which takes place 6 times in an academic year. Below, you find some information on the topics that are most relevant for students.

### Corona update

During the last months, multiple scenarios have been worked out for the upcoming academic year, namely a 0-meter scenario, 0,5-meter scenario and an 1,5-meter scenario. The final decision on which scenario to follow will depend on the advice of the ministry of education, which is given mid-august. Hence, the next update will be given to you mid-august.

Furthermore, the faculty will try to drastically reduce the number of online tests from home during next academic year. Evaluations have shown that this type of examination form is not desirable and therefore on-campus exams are preferred.

### Update on “Uniformization of Course Syllabi”

The final template for the course syllabi was presented to the faculty council and it got approved. Accordingly, all Academic Directors and teaching staff will be informed about the new syllabus template and encouraged to use it for next academic year. We hope that all course coordinators will use it, and we will urge for this as well during next academic year.

### Update on EER MSc Data Science & Entrepreneurship

Due to a Memo handed in by ECCO, the EER of the MSc Data Science and Entrepreneurship on the JADS was adjusted and officially approved so that exams will be checked at the latest 5 working days before a resit.



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### Master programs eligible for BSc Entrepreneurship and Business Innovation students

We have urged the Management Team to announce as soon as possible the conditions for EBI students to enter the master programs offered at TiSEM. Not all conditions are yet clear for every master, and we think this should be done soon so that students can take this into account when choosing their Minor or taking on additional courses.
